

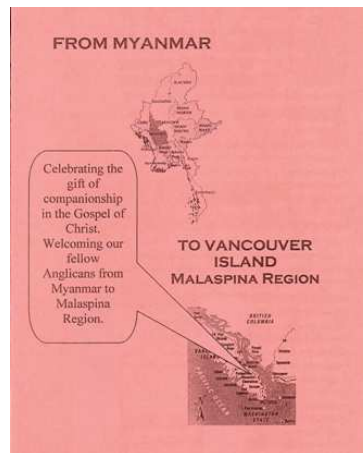
Our Brothers and Sisters from Myanmar visit St. Mary.
